Subject:- Supply of textile items by the J&K State Handloom Development Corporation Limited to various departments.

As per Govt. Order No: 1456-GAD of 1983, issued by the (General Administration Department, vide NO. GD/(Adm)53/83-Ird, dated 20.9.83, all the Government Departments are required to make the purchase of all types of textile items only from the J&K State Handloom Development Corporation Limited (J&KSHDC). The prices of these products are fixed on yearly basis by a High Powered Committee, headed by the Principal Secretary, Finance Department, after which orders for supply can be placed on the J&K State Handloom Development Corporation Limited by the indenting Govt. Departments without inviting tenders or quotations. No decision is required to be taken by the purchase committees on prices and departments have only to ensure that they receive the goods as per the prescribed specifications.

It has been brought to the notice of the Finance Department that, occasionally, some Departments are violating the Govt. orders by purchasing textile items from suppliers other than the J&K SHDC. Such violations have been viewed seriously by the State Govt and, apart from acting against the Govt. policy of promoting handloom products within the state through the efforts of J&K SHDC, this amounts to indiscipline. All Govt. departments are impressed upon to make purchase of their textile requirements from the State Handloom Dev. Corporation only on the prices/rates fixed by the High Powered Committee in its meeting, held on 11.7.2012, under the chairmanship of the Principal Secretary to Government, Finance Department, and ensure compliance of the aforementioned Govt. orders.

The Financial Advisers/Chief Accounts Officers and Accounts Officers, posted in various departments, shall personally ensure compliance of these instructions and the concerned Treasury Officers shall not pass the bills for payments, presented to them, on account of such purchases made from sources other than the JKSHDC.





The prices of these products are fixed on yearly basis by a High Powered Committee, after which orders for supply can be placed on the J&K State Handloom Development Corporation Limited by the indenting Government Departments without inviting tenders or quotations.

It has been observed that some Departments are violating the Government orders by purchasing textile items from suppliers other than the J&K HDC. Such violations have been viewed seriously by the State Government and, apart from acting against the Government policy of promoting Handloom Products within the state through the efforts of J&K SHDC.

All Government Departments are impressed upon to make purchase of the textile requirements in their Departments from the State Handloom Development Corporation only on the prices/rates fixed by the High Powered committee in its meeting held on 08-05-2015 and ensure compliance of the aforementioned Government orders.

The Financial Advisors/Chief Accounts Officers and Accounts Officers, posted in various departments, shall personally ensure compliance of these instructions and the concerned Treasury Officers shall not pass the bills for payments, presented to them, on account of such purchases made from sources other than the JKSHDC.
