The goods supplied shall be new, having incorporated all recent improvements in design and materials unless provided otherwise in the supply order. The warranty on the goods shall remain valid for the minimum of 24 months, or any portion thereof as the case may be, after the Goods have been commissioned to J&K State Handloom Development Corp Ltd, as indicated in the supply order and accepted. The Bidder shall also arrange to provide user training to Operating staff, senior executives or such other persons nominated by the Purchaser for the training on the machines/equipments. Documents shall be supplied for installation. Maintenance, servicing and operation of the equipment. The servicing manual shall cover all the procedures and information necessary for the diagnosis and repair of faulty units or components of the goods The Bidder shall also ensure all necessary maintenance of the machines/ equipments for next 5 years after the acceptance of the goods on a continuing basis at a reasonable price, at the option of the purchaser.

The Bidder shall also ensure supply of spare parts for the goods at last for a period of four years from the date of purchase of items. In case of phasing out or discontinuation of production of any of the spare parts, required for the maintenance of the goods, he will give at least six months, notice prior to such discontinuation to the Purchaser.
